The SD&A committee have organized a bus tour to visit two local 3D companies in Silicon Valley – Intuitive Surgical and NVIDIA. Both companies are strong users and supporters of stereoscopic imaging in their products and this is a unique opportunity to visit these two companies.

About the companies:

Intuitive Surgical develops and markets a telerobotic surgery system called 'da Vinci' which uses a stereoscopic display and endoscopic stereoscopic camera as an integral part of the system. The da Vinci system is remarkable in that it optically aligns the stereoscopic image of the robotic manipulators with the operator's two hands which makes the system very intuitive to use - hence the company's name. The company has installed over 2800 da Vinci systems worldwide - the system is most common used for hysterectomy and prostatectomy surgeries. Intuitive Surgical is a quiet achiever in the stereoscopic imaging industry and this is a very special opportunity for SD&A tour attendees to be able to visit and experience the da Vinci system.

NVIDIA have been a strong supporter of stereoscopic imaging technologies for more than 12 years. NVIDIA's stereoscopic solutions have been a critical component of the success of many stereoscopic imaging systems due to the fundamental and enabling capabilities that NVIDIA graphics cards provide. SD&A tour attendees will visit the NVIDIA campus in Santa Clara and get a chance to see a range of NVIDIA enabled stereoscopic display solutions in the flesh and hear from NVIDIA technology experts.
